APPEAL FOR FUNDS TO ASSIST MEET THE EXPENSES REQUIRED TO PURCHASE LEARNING MATERIALS AND TEXTBOOKS FOR DISPLACED AND DISADVANTAGED BURMESE MIGRANT CHILDREN AND YOUTH LIVING ALONG THE BORDERS OF THAILAND AND MYANMAR.

Commencing over five years ago, the current civil war in Myanmar has resulted in many thousands of deaths and the displacement of millions of people fleeing forced conscription, indiscriminate air strikes and ethnic violence.

In the fishing town of Ranong, Thailand, the Marist Fathers work to educate displaced and disadvantaged Burmese migrant children and teenagers living along the borders of Thailand and Myanmar. Currently these children and youth face the prospect of working in fish factories, rubber plantations and charcoal factories without any hope for a brighter future.

The Marist Fathers Asia Foundation *Burmese Migrant Secondary Education Programme (BMSP)* provides over 250 students with an education integrating learning skills in Myanmar, Thai and English language, focusing on mathematics, language arts and science. Their goal is for the students to obtain an internationally recognized high school diploma resulting in better opportunities for work in the future.

The aim of this appeal is to provide funds to sustain this education program, especially supporting the purchase of teaching materials and textbooks.
